Only Leadership New Mexico Alumni are eligible to receive this award. No self-nominations please. Nominees should be individuals who have demonstrated exceptional leadership that has resulted in a significant impact on the economy and quality of life at the local or state level of New Mexico. The recipient must have demonstrated dynamic leadership skills in multiple settings and have achieved extraordinary success in the goals he or she has set out to accomplish.
