



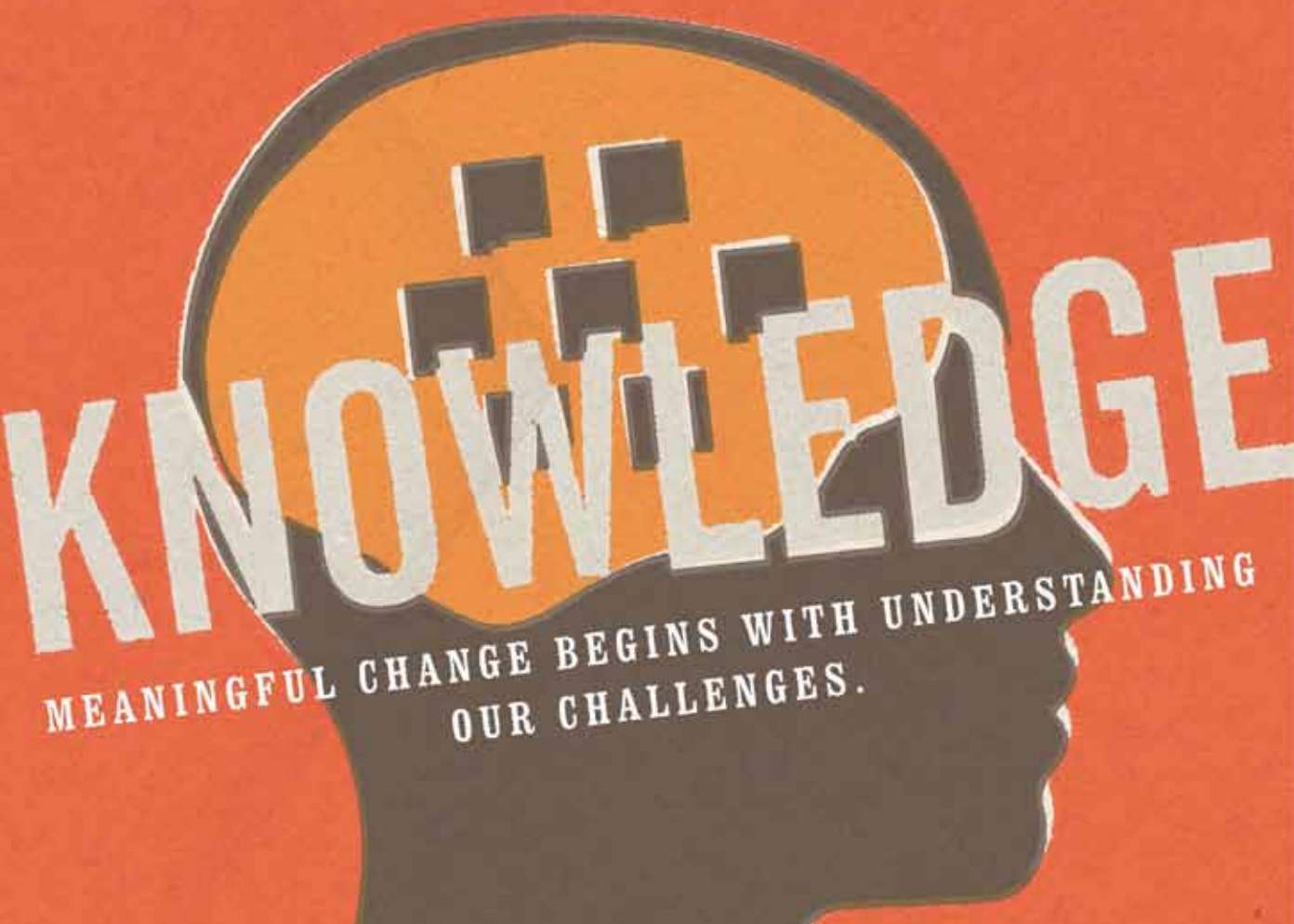

#### CORE PROGRAM

The Core Program brings a group of influential leaders from around the state together for an experience that is unique to Leadership New Mexico. The ten-month, six-session program, is designed to educate participants about critical issues in New Mexico. Each session features expert speakers and offers an opportunity for inquiry, analysis, and the discussion of solutions to some of New Mexico's most pressing problems. The Core Program includes educational sessions on topics such as health and human services, economic development, education, environment and natural resources, government, crime and justice, and leadership. The diversity of perspectives of each participant, the breadth of knowledge and expertise of the speakers, and the distinct communities in which program sessions are held provide for a valuable experience.

## **LOCAL GOVERNMENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM**

The Local Government Leadership Program is an educational partnership between the New Mexico Municipal League, the New Mexico Association of Counties, the New Mexico School Boards Association, and Leadership New Mexico. The organizations joined together to provide a unique educational experience for municipal and county officials, New Mexico school boards, members of the National Guard, and regional councils of governments. The curriculum is patterned after the Leadership New Mexico Core Program to offer civic leaders the opportunity to explore the critical issues facing New Mexico and to participate in skill-building workshops. The Local Government Leadership Program seeks to prepare local officials with the background and knowledge necessary to undertake their civic responsibility and instill in them a passion for effective and ethical public service.

## **CONNECT NEW MEXICO**

Connect New Mexico, *The Next Generation of Leadership*, is a program for 25 to 40 year-old leaders from around the state. The curriculum combines elements of the Core Program and the Local Government Leadership Program and includes leadership skill development. Connect New Mexico offers young professionals the opportunity to develop personal leadership skills, learn how New Mexico systems and structures work, and explore the critical issues facing the state. The process encourages participants to cultivate new ideas and leadership techniques as well as understand some of New Mexico's most pressing challenges. The Connect New Mexico Program creates a bond between young professionals, the communities they live in, and the State of New Mexico, while helping them gain the skills they need to be effective, influential leaders. The program provides participants with tools they can take back to their communities to develop positive change and create initiatives to improve the quality of life.

## **THE ALUMNI PROGRAM**

The Alumni Program furthers the education and challenges the thinking and perspectives of Leadership New Mexico graduates. The program promotes the interaction of graduates from across programs and classes in order to expose alumni to a diversity of education, experiences, and regional perspectives, and to help develop the professional and personal relationships that are one of the most valuable aspects of Leadership New Mexico.

# 2013 - 2014

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Leadership New Mexico honored Don Chalmers, Posthumously, President of Don Chalmers Companies, with the 2014 Distinguished Leadership Award and Bill Fulginiti, Executive Director of the New Mexico Municipal League, Core Class of 2003, with the 2014 Distinguished Alumnus Award at the Annual Awards Dinner held on Friday, May 2, 2014.
- Leadership New Mexico has had nearly 1,200 participants from 76 communities in one of the three programs.
- Leadership New Mexico completed the eighteenth Core Program class, graduating 40 participants from 17 communities, for a total of 727 participants from 52 communities since the program began.
- The seventh class of the Connect New Mexico, *The Next Generation of Leadership*, program graduated 28 participants from 13 communities, for a total of 197 participants from 32 communities since the program began.
- The Local Government Leadership Program is an educational partnership between the New Mexico Municipal League, the New Mexico Association of Counties, the New Mexico School Boards Association, and Leadership New Mexico. This year, the program graduated its twelfth class with 23 civic leaders from 16 communities, making a total of 245 officials from 38 municipalities, 27 counties, 11 school districts, six New Mexico Army National Guards, and two Regional Councils of Government since the program began.
- For the seventh year, the generosity of Trudy and Ed Healy and the Healy Foundation provided scholarship support for Local Government Leadership Program participants through the funding of the Bill Fulginiti Scholarship Fund.
- Leadership New Mexico took alumni on tours of Eclipse Aerospace, URENCO USA, and ReelzChannel.
- The eighth annual golf tournament was held at Sandia Resort and Casino and was sold out, with 144 golfers from around the state.
- Since the creation of the Leadership New Mexico Endowment in 2009, 135 Lifetime Members have invested in the future of Leadership New Mexico and the state. The Endowment ensures the long-term financial stability of Leadership New Mexico and its programs and services.

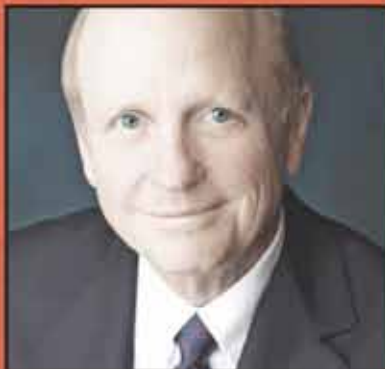

## AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

The Distinguished Leadership Award and the Distinguished Alumnus Award recognize individuals who have used their leadership skills to improve the quality of life for New Mexican citizens.



The posthumous recipient of this year's Distinguished Leadership Award is **Don Chalmers**, a Tulsa, Oklahoma native who moved to New Mexico 17 years ago. Don was the owner of auto dealerships in Rio Rancho, Santa Fe, and Albuquerque and was very active in these communities. Don served on a number of healthcare, economic development, and community service boards, and promoted vocational service within the automobile industry. One of the core values of Don's dealerships was to proactively partner with the community. He instilled the importance of philanthropy in his companies and believed they should support the communities that they serve.



The recipient of this year's Distinguished Alumnus Award is **Bill Fulginitti**, Executive Director of the New Mexico Municipal League. Bill serves as the Vice Chairman of the New Mexico Finance Authority and the Water Trust Board. Bill was recently a recipient of the Governor's Distinguished Public Service Award and the New Mexico Distinguished Public Administration Award. Bill's public service experience also extends nationally with two terms on the Board of the National League of Cities.
